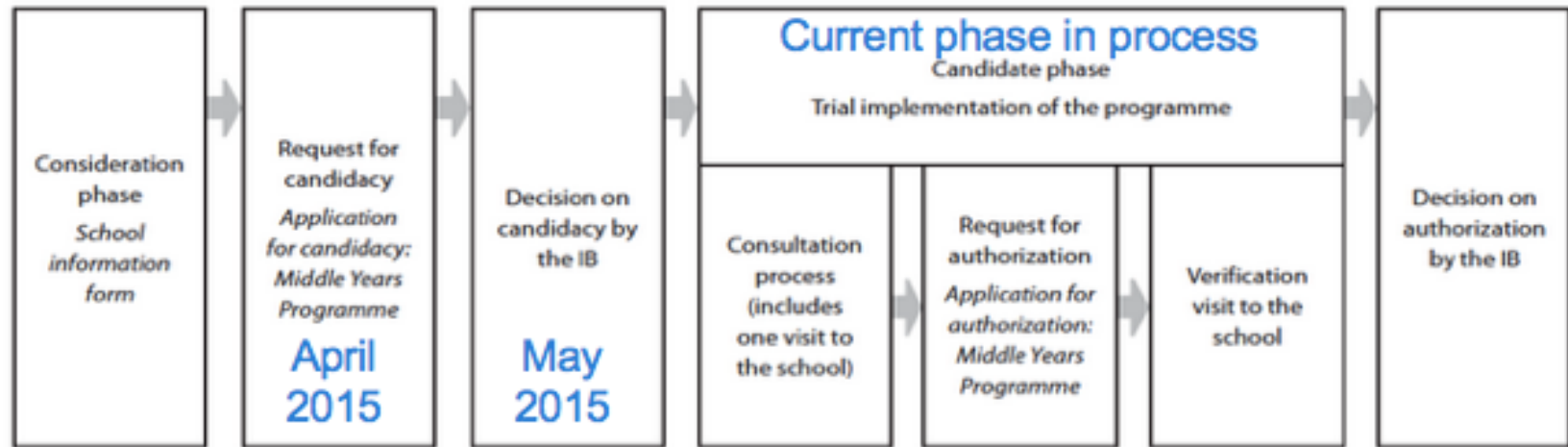
# Learner Profile of the Month

- ⌘ October- Knowledgeable (red)
- ⌘ November- Risk-taker (brown)
- ⌘ December- Open-minded (dark green)
- ⌘ January- Reflective (light blue)
- ⌘ February- Caring (pink)
- ⌘ March- Balanced (Panther blue)
- ⌘ April- Communicator (yellow)
- ⌘ May- Inquirer (lime green)
