Dress Code Basics

- PVMS follows district dress code guidelines. That means: no baggie pants, no spaghetti straps, no offensive graphics or language, no sunglasses, hats or chain wallets.
- YES, you can wear flip flops and sandals.
- NO, you can't wear pajamas, leggings, or pajama pants.

Dress Code: Leggings Are NOT Pants!



- You **MUST** wear a skirt or shorts over your leggings.
- The skirt or shorts must **NOT** be more than 4 inches above your knee!

Dress Code: It's Still See Through Even With a Tank Top!

- Tank top straps should be THREE fingers wide. EVEN if they are under a shirt!
- That means that you can not wear spaghetti strap camisoles or tiny tank tops under a see through lace shirt!
- **Pasco County Student Code of Conduct:**
- The principal, or designee, shall determine the appropriateness of dress and appearance. The principal, or designee, will make the decision if a student's appearance meets school and community standards. The principal's decision on the appropriateness of dress is final.

Cell Phone Policy
