



PVMS Meet the Teacher Day
August 19, 2020
Information for Option #1: Traditional
AND Option #2: mySchool Panthers



Pine View Middle School is excited to offer Meet the Teacher Day options for all Panthers!

- **Option #1:** Traditional Panther students Meet the Teacher Day on Wednesday, August 19th by appointment only at Pine View Middle School.
- **Option #2:** mySchool Panthers will have a Virtual Meet the Teacher Day on Wednesday, August 19, 2020 through a link on our website.



STEP 1: Complete Your Course!

Prior to Meet the Teacher Day (August 19th) there are 2 courses available to orient students to PVMS, IB, the new school year and update Panthers about the changes to the learning environment. (Year 1 students and new to PVMS students will take the All Paws In, Years 2 & 3 will take the Panthers Protecting Everyone (PPE) course.) Upon completion of the designated courses,

- **Option #1:** Traditional students can access a Sign-Up Genius link in the last module of the course to schedule an appointment to come on campus.
- **Option #2:** mySchool students, no sign up is necessary.

All Paws In (Incoming Year 1's and New to PVMS students)

This course has been designed for **all** Year 1 Traditional and mySchool Panthers along with any **new** Year 2 and 3 Panthers that enrolled during the summer for this upcoming school year. At the end of the course,

- **Option #1:** Traditional Panthers, will be able to schedule an appointment for Wednesday, August 19th for one adult and one student to walk their schedule at Pine View Middle School. (There will also be an option for multi-year level families)
- **Option #2:** mySchool Panthers will **not be scheduling an appointment** on August 19th to come into the building, instead they will find a link on our website and social media on the 19th that will have videos of their teachers to be able to meet them virtually.

Panther Protecting Everyone (PPE) Expectations (returning Year 2 & 3 students)

This course has been designed for all Years 2 and 3 Traditional and mySchool Panthers. At the end of the PPE Expectations course,

- **Option #1:** Traditional Panthers, will be able to schedule an appointment for Wednesday, August 19th for one adult and one student to walk their schedule at Pine View Middle School. (There will also be an option for multi-year level families)
- **Option #2:** mySchool Panthers will **not be scheduling an appointment** on August 19th to come into the building, instead they will find a link on our website and social media on the 19th that will have videos of their teachers to be able to meet them virtually.



STEP 2: Pay, Purchase, Update, Acknowledge, Preview & Print



Set Up a Parent Portal MyStudent Account

It will be very important that **ALL** Panthers (Option #1: Traditional **AND** Option #2: mySchool) guardian/parent have established a myStudent parent portal and a myLearning parent observer account so that they are prepared and will be able to access:

- Update: child's virtual emergency card (August 19th)
- Pay: school fees (August 19th)
- Acknowledge: code of conduct and Covid information (August 19th)
- Purchase: spirit wear or PE uniforms (optional) on RYCOR (starting August 5th)
- Preview & Print your child's schedule (August 19th).

Helpful Hints:

- *There will be no stations set up on Meet the Teacher Day to pay for school fees, PE uniform, PVMS spirit wear, etc. or to print schedules, this must be done virtually.*
- *New accounts can take 24 hours after creation to be operating, please make any new accounts prior to August 18th to ensure you have access on August 19th.*

Year 2 Students Required Immunization Forms:

ALL Year Two students (both traditional and virtual) who have not shared their immunization records with Pine View Middle School will need to scan and email to cgmartin@pasco.k12.fl.us, fax (813)794-4891 or drop off in the front office prior to the first day of school. Option #1 students will not be permitted to attend their first period class if this is not on file. Option #2 students will be removed from this option if the requirement has not been submitted by Friday, August 14, 2020.



STEP 3: Meet the Teacher Day (Option 1: Traditional Students)

These appointments are opportunities to walk your schedule and meet your teachers. The appointments are only 15 minutes (20 minutes for multi-year level families). Please arrive to the "Arriving Tent" 5-10 minutes before your appointment to check-in. There will be an announcement at the end of your appointment time to exit campus and check-out at the "Departure Tent". Please have all documents printed or as a screenshot on your phone. No printers will be available and no pay stations will be available on campus.

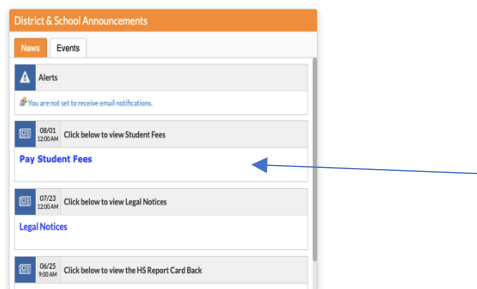
- Have a scheduled appointment that includes only PVMS students and one parent.
- Park in the designated Staff parking lot area to the north of the PVMS building.
- Wear your masks at all times.
- Pay for fees and spirit apparel on your MyStudent parent portal before arrival.
- Print students' schedule. (from MyStudent)
- Print a school map. (from the PVMS website)
- Map out your route to maximize your time.

Hints, Tips, and Help for Completing On-line Requirements:

Where do I pay student fees?

In your MyStudent Parent Portal (see image below)



I have a new parent portal account, how do I activate the account?

Activate your Parent Portal Account by selecting “Activate Account” on the screen. Enter the email address associated with your myStudent account and select “Send Email” which generates an email to activate the account. Go to your email and select the link. Continue by creating your password. Once this is completed, you will be able to see the school fees.

I need to request a schedule change, how do I do that?

We will not be entertaining schedule change requests during the Meet the Teacher Day. Please note that requests may not be granted in an effort to balance the needs of students in both Option #1: Traditional and Option #2: mySchool along with the fluid situation of our current reality. Do I need my schedule on the first day of school?

In an effort to continue balancing classes and meeting the needs of our Option #1 and Option #2 students after the Meet the Teacher Day, schedules will be re-printed and distributed to students on Monday, August 24th, the first day of school. An alphabetical list of students with their first period teacher and room number will be posted throughout the school on Monday, August 24th, along with a number of staff members making themselves available to assist students. No families will be allowed in the building except for students.

What if I order spirit gear and pe uniforms online, where do I pick it up?

If you ordered PE uniforms and/or Panther spirit gear online, these items will be packaged and sent home with Option #1 students in the first couple of weeks of school. Option #2 students that ordered PE uniforms and/or spirit gear may make an appointment for pick up by calling the front desk.

I have questions about bus transportation or need to change my bus information, what do I do?

Option #1: Traditional students that have a Bus Pass Change (add or change a bus pass)

Call our Transportation Office (813) 794-0528

Transportation relies on information in MyStudent to issue bus passes for students. It is important for you to ensure your student's address information is accurate and update as needed, directly with their school. Updated bus passes will be issued and available in your MyStudent portal within 48 hours. You can print this screen or snap a picture for reference later. Bus passes for students with an IEP or 504 can take up to 7 days to coordinate transportation.
