



Description of Arts & Design:

Physical & Health Education: Will be paired with student's choice of design

Band: Students with little or no instrumental experience develop foundational instrumental technique, music literary and setthetic musical swareness through rebensal, performance and study of high-quality band literature. Students may be required to eitheid and/or participate in rehearsals and performances outside the school day and may be required to obtain a musical instrument (e.g. borrow, rent, or purchase) from an outside source of the properties of the

Chorus 1: Students with little or no choral experience develop vocal technique and skills, critical and creative thinking skills, and an appreciation of music from around the world and through time. Students may be required to attend and/or participate in rehearsals and performances outside the school day.

Intro to Art History (Visual Art): Students take an inquiry-based approach to exploring, researching and analyzing works of art across time and cultures.

Dance Techniques (Performing Art): Dance technique is a semester class designed to introduce a variety of dance techniques and gennes. This class will focus on introductory movement and continually build upon proviously acquired dance concepts. Daste dance vacabulary, performance skills, choreography, improvisation and performance appreciation skills will be explored.

Basic Theatre (Performing Art): Students interested in theatre will learn the basics of theatre arts by exploring a character through such activities as pantemine, improvisation and effecting speaking using articulation, projection and breathing

Agriculture: Exploration of career opportunities and job-required tasks performed in a broad range of agricultural occupations.

Culinary: Exploration of career opportunities, food safety and zanitation; safe and proper use of culinary tools/equipment; interpreting recipes and basic food properation skills.

Technology: Exploration of production technology and its associated careers.

Graphic Arts: Exploration of careers in the Arts, A/V Technology & Communications.






