Dear MSOL Family,

Florida State Assessment windows will begin in April and run through the end of May. All students are required to take their assessment on campus, there is no remote option for the FSA and EOC assessments. Our goal is to help students feel confident, safe, and successful during their testing session. MSOL students will need to be dropped off for their scheduled test session and picked up at the end of their scheduled test session. Students will be required to bring their device and charger if they checked one out from PVMS, earbuds or headphones that plug into the device (no Bluetooth allowed), be in dress code and must wear a face covering while on campus. Students may choose to bring a snack, water bottle, and a book to read after testing. Students who receive accommodations during exams will be provided with an individualized schedule and may need to contact a parent when the test session is complete for pick up.

ALL MSOL STUDENTS MUST COME ON CAMPUS TO COMPLETE STATE TESTING. The testing dates for each assessment are listed below with the required testing time and tentative schedule for each testing session. Students will receive a confirmed testing schedule with their testing room number the week prior to their scheduled test. Students will need to be dropped off in the front of the school and report directly to their testing location, staff will be present to help students find their location. If students have a device and charger that has been checked out from PVMS they must bring that device and charger with them for testing, along with earbuds or headphones, be in dress code and a face covering. Students who receive testing accommodations per their 504 or IEP will have an individualized schedule and may have alternative drop off and pick-up times.

Algebra EOC – Students must sit for 90-minutes each session 1 and 2 but may use up to $\frac{1}{2}$ school day

Algebra Students Session 1 - Monday, May 10th - Drop Off 8:30 and Pickup 10:30

Algebra Students Session 2 – Tuesday, May 11th – Drop Off 8:30 and Pickup 10:30

Students who use extra time will have to notify parents of later pickup time.

Civics EOC - Students must sit for 80-minute session but may use up to 1 whole school day

Mr. Moore's Students - Wednesday, May 12th - Drop Off 8:30 and Pickup 10:30

Mrs. Cooper's Students - Thursday, May 13th - Drop Off 8:30 and Pickup 10:30

Ms. Adkins' Students - Friday, May 14th - Drop Off 8:30 and Pickup 10:30
