Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

Pine View Middle School would like to stress the importance of adhering to the car rider loading/unloading procedures to ensure that our students arrive/dismiss from school safely and efficiently. In the morning, all child(ren) will remain in their vehicles until a staff member initiates the car rider process. It is important for all child(ren) to be dropped off at the north end of the sidewalk in front of the school and to be picked up at the north end of the sidewalk in front of the school in the coned off area. ALL exiting traffic from the car rider line will turn right on to Parkway Boulevard to create a consistent stream of moving traffic. Please remember that an illegal turn around on Parkway Boulevard may be enforced by the Pasco County Sheriff's Office. At no time should the bus parking lot area be used to drop off or turn around in while buses and students are present. This is a major safety issue.

Every car will move ALL the way up along the sidewalk in the car rider area before dropping off/picking up their child to assist with the efficiency of the process in the am/pm. At no time should any child(ren) be dropped off on Parkway Boulevard, in the bus parking area, and/or a car vacated along the sidewalk in the active car rider line. When children are dropped off/picked up randomly along the sidewalk, Parkway Boulevard or the bus parking lot area, it creates a "bottleneck" effect and a safety hazard along with compromising the efficiency of the process.

If for any reason, a child(ren) needs to unload/load several items, it is encouraged that parents pull into a parking spot and assist the student using the pedestrian crosswalk in front of the main office so that the active car rider line is not compromised.

A few tips to assist parents with a smooth drop off/pick up is to have your child dropped off no earlier than 8:00am. In the afternoon, students are released at 2:30pm and all students must be picked up no later than 3:00pm. Students are not supervised before 8:00am and after 3:00pm.

Our School Resource Officer will be assisting with the enforcement of these procedures throughout the year.

Please remember that the safety of all our students and families is paramount and that the maximum speed in the school zone speed is 20mph.

We appreciate all our families for exhibit kindness and patience with the unloading and loading process for the safety of all stakeholders.
