- The International Baccalaureate® (IB) Middle Years Programme (MYP) emphasizes intellectual challenge. It encourages students to make practical connections between their studies and the real world, preparing them for success in further study and in life.
- The MYP aims to develop active learners and internationally minded young people who can empathize with others and pursue lives of purpose and meaning. The programme empowers students to inquire into a wide range of issues and ideas of significance locally, nationally and globally. The result is young people who are creative, critical and reflective thinkers.

How do we plan at PVMS so that students retain and apply their knowledge in a real world setting ?



- MYP Unit Planning: Teachers collaborate to plan units with their year level (grade), subject area and interdisciplinary colleagues.
- Driving force of the unit is the Statement of Inquiry : Gives purpose and a focus to the unit.
- The summative assessment is a performance based task for each unit that allows for students to demonstrate their knowledge of each unit's Statement of Inquiry.
