Digital Citizenship

- Electronic devices are **NOT** required or needed in school.
- Electronic devices are allowed on campus but must stay in backpacks on silent.
- Students are solely responsible for taking care of and keeping track of their electronic devices.
- Using a personal device during school is **NOT ALLOWED**.
- **PVMS is not responsible for any damage to or loss of personal devices.**
- Students should **NOT** share devices with others.
- Principled Panthers do not view, record, or share inappropriate content.
- Devices used for cyber-bullying or criminal activity may be confiscated by the School Resource Officer.
- *Use of school provided electronic devices is a **privilege** and can be revoked if students are not making principled decisions when using school property.*
- Wired headphones are recommended for school.
- Airpods do not work with all school provided devices and are **not allowed to be used during school or any classroom, district or state testing where listening is required.**

District Device Policy:

and silent.**

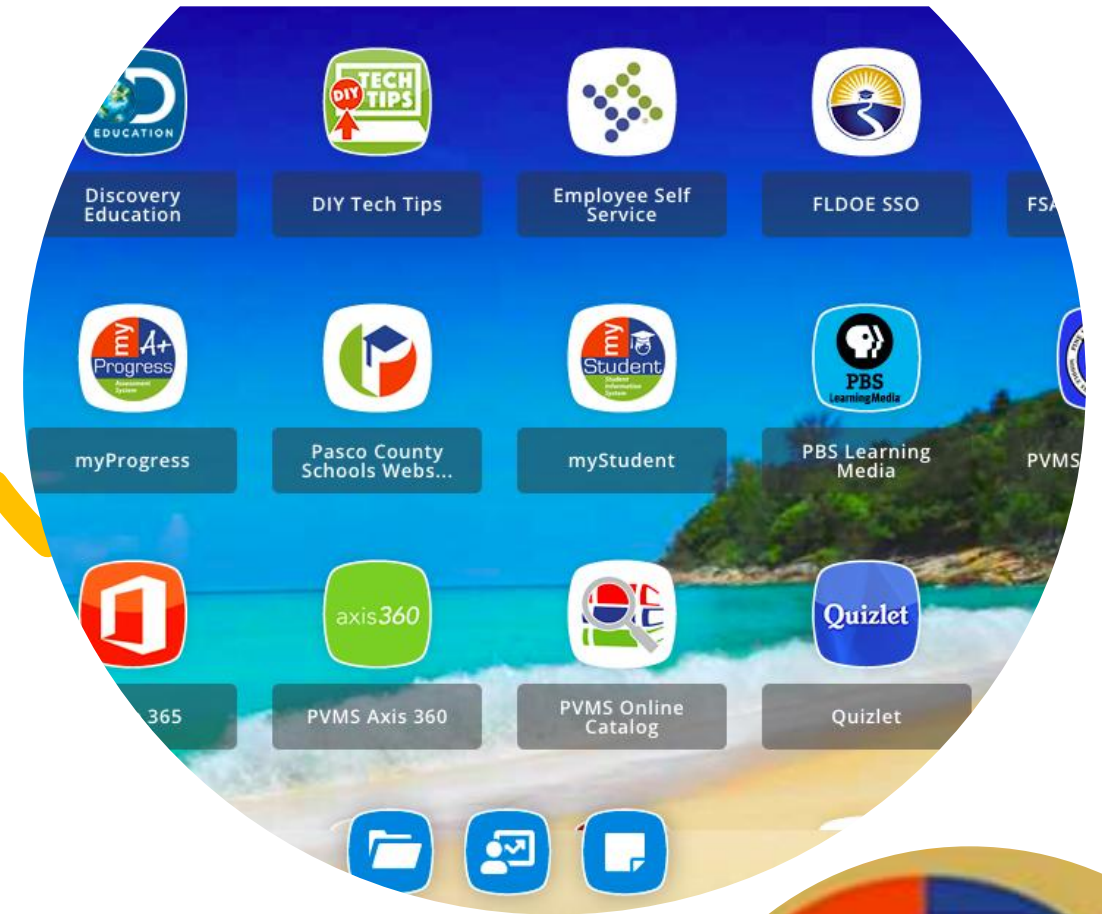


**All Wireless Communication Devices

MyPascoConnect

- Every student has a myPascoConnect dashboard.
- Students will need to access their dashboard at school and at home.
- This dashboard has **all** of their important links such as: myStudent, myLearning, Office365, and all of their textbooks.
- myStudent will be used for two-way communication between school and home via email and text messaging.



MyStudent

- It is imperative that all parents have a myStudent account to access your child's grades, progress reports, report cards and schedule.
- Students will all have access via their myPascoConnect dashboard.
- Your account can be set up by visiting the Parent section of the Pasco County Schools website.
- Grades should be checked by parents weekly at a minimum. Model how to do this for your child.
- Teachers will communicate with parents via myStudent.
